



Suburban Symphony Orchestra 2008 Young Soloists' Concerto Competition Audition Information

1. The Young Soloists Concert will be presented on **Sunday, March 16th, 2008 at 3:30 p.m. in the Beachwood High School Auditorium**. Rehearsals will be held on Wednesday evenings and on the Saturday morning before the Sunday performance.
2. Soloists must presently be aged 13-18 and enrolled in grades 7 through 12 or equivalent. **Previous winners are not eligible to participate.**
3. **Auditions will be held on Saturday and Sunday, January 5 and 6, 2008 at University School Upper Campus, 2785 SOM Center Road, between Fairmount and Shaker Boulevards.** Each applicant will be notified by phone as to the exact time of the audition.
4. There is a **\$20 audition fee**, due with your completed application. Please make checks payable to the Suburban Symphony Orchestra.
5. Each applicant may play any standard concerto or movement from a concerto and should audition on the work he or she intends to perform. Memorization is strongly encouraged.
6. Auditions may not exceed twenty minutes. Students may audition on an entire concerto, but final determination of the movement or movements to be performed will be made by the audition committee.
7. All soloists, including pianists, must audition with piano accompaniment.
8. Applicants must provide one copy of the solo part for the judges.
9. Selection of soloists may in part be made with programming and instrumentation considerations in mind. All applicants will be notified of the judges' decision by mail. Copies of the judges' comments are available on request. Email your request to suburbansymphony@gmail.com. The decision of the audition committee is final.
